Part-Time Teacher Position Focus Sheet

Position: Part-time Teacher

JOB DESCRIPTION:

The job of the **Teacher** is to work with individuals and small groups of elementary aged students under the supervision of the MAM Education Coordinator and Neighborhood Director of that site. **The Teacher** will provide a strong passion for sharing the gospel of Christ to help grow the students' spirituality. In addition this job also requires instruction to students that will create a positive learning environment challenging students to grow personally, socially and academically.

Teacher Focus

- Prepare materials and equipment for after school instructional activities.
- Assist students with homework assignments and provide tutorial and I-station/I-ready or other District on-line tutoring/enrichment services as needed.
- Make regular school visits and establish relationship with school staff and personnel.
- Welcome and supervise the work of volunteers & service learning students assigned.
- Do anything and everything necessary to present MAM to our youth and to others in a Christlike, professional manner including but not limited to serving as classroom tutors, managing daily operation of afterschool programs, maintaining the cleanliness of the facility, conducting weekly Bible studies, conducting daily devotionals as needed, working hand-in-hand with other staff members as a team and sharing the gospel the groups and individuals.

Character

- Need to be a follower of Jesus Christ reflecting our mission and vision in your walk with Him (see below)
- Need to be pursuing a holy lifestyle of reaching out friends, family and others with the love of Christ
- Need to be able to strike the balance between challenging youths' growth and expectations while enjoying the fun season of life that they are in
- Need to serve all youth, and see each of them as a unique child of God.
- Need to be able to engage and minister to youths and parents in a way that would never arouse suspicion about the moral integrity of yourself or the ministry.
- Need to believe that every student has the ability to learn.

Skills

- Be able to communicate the Word of God effectively in large and small group settings as well as one on one.
- Be able to use sports as a connecting point with kids (playing and coaching).
- Be able to vary the methods necessary, to meet the needs of the ministry.
- Be able to work with others and through others by recruiting, equipping and encouraging.
- Be able to create high expectations of all students.
