



Part-Time Literacy Coach

Position Summary

Literacy Coaches will work with small groups of elementary and/or middle school aged students under the supervision of the MAM Academics Director and Neighborhood Director. Literacy Coaches will also receive oversight and instruction from Youth Coordinators to maximize impact in the classroom. Literacy Coaches will build relationships with MAM youth through literacy instruction to increase knowledge and passion for reading. Literacy Coaches will be responsible for creating a positive classroom environment that promotes learning and respect among all students. Literacy Coaches will be the primary face of the literacy program at a site and play a role in helping students find their identity in Christ and purpose in the community.

Responsibilities

- Plan and prepare materials for after school instructional activities with curriculum provided by the Academics Director
- Assist volunteers in providing tutoring/enrichment services as needed
- Create an engaging and fun environment in the classroom
- Provide literacy instruction to small groups (15 or less) of students each day
- Participate in weekly/monthly staff meetings as necessary
- Maintain cleanliness and organization in the classroom
- Work with a diverse team of individuals to accomplish the goals and objectives of the literacy program.

- Able to effectively communicate the Word of God
- Comfortable using academics as a connecting point with kids through literacy and learning
