



Part-Time Youth Coordinator

Position Summary

The Youth Coordinator is responsible for assisting in the daily programming and operations of a MAM neighborhood center. Daily operations include, but are not limited to: Using organized sports to draw at-risk neighborhood youth to the site; creating a nurturing environment by leading small mentoring groups; and administering comprehensive programs that address the physical, mental, social and spiritual needs of youth. The part-time Youth Coordinator reports to the Neighborhood Director. In some cases, part-time Youth Coordinator may directly report to full-time Youth Coordinator.

Responsibilities

- Assist with ministering to a group of age specific youth
- Participates in weekly staff meetings and staff development training as required
- Help develop productive relationships with neighborhood schools and partner churches
- Maximize participation in MAM activities; meets or exceeds positional goals and objectives
- Maintain site cleanliness and maximize facility utilization
- Submit regular paperwork in a timely manner
- Coach teams in various sports to engage students

Requirements:

- A follower of Christ, representing our mission, vision and core values in their personal life inside and outside of MAM
- Able to effectively communicate the Word of God in all settings
- Comfortable using sport as a connecting point with kids through playing and coaching
- In compliance with the MAM "Statement of Faith" and MAM Playbook
- Spiritually mature member of a local church
- Able to effectively implement MAM programming
- Able to lead children of all ages
