## Position Summary

The part-time After school Coach reports to the After School Coordinator with close guidance and direction from the After School Director/Neighborhood director. This role is crucial in engaging youth through high energy enrichment activities and trauma informed practices to mentor and minister the gospel of Jesus Christ.

- Encouraging kids to be on a sports team
- Leading recreational activities
- Assist with the operation of MAM leagues or tournaments when needed
- Create a fun and engaging environment for students to learn and be developed
- Lead Bible studies, enrichment, and youth activities to engage students with the gospel and grow their faith
- Use systems provided to track youth in bible studies, academics, and social-emotional development
- Participate in weekly staff meetings and staff development training, as required
- Assist in helping maintain the cleanliness of the building
